ABOUT THE TRAINING

COST

Training costs are \$1,100* per day, and include:

- Access to all training mechanisms, including Burn Tunnel, in SIC's Fire Science Training Center.
- Indoor and/or outdoor classrooms.
- Shower accessibility.
- College credit toward Fire and Mine Rescue Safety Certificate.

-Directions to Southeastern Illinois College-

From Interstate 64: Follow US-45 South for approximately 47 miles to Harrisburg, Illinois. Take IL-13 East 5 miles, then turn left on College Road. Turn right at first entrance to SIC Campus.

From Interstate 57: Follow IL-13 East approximately 24 miles to Harrisburg. Continue on IL-13 east for 5 miles outside of Harrisburg city limits, then turn left on College Road. Turn right at the first entrance to SIC Campus.

From Interstate 24: Merge with 1-57 North and continue 9 miles to Harrisburg exit. Follow IL-13 East approximately 24 miles to Harrisburg. Continue on IL-13 east for 5 miles outside of Harrisburg city limits, then turn left on College Road. Turn right at first entrance to SIC Campus.
