C.N.A. 131 Certified Nurse Assisting (7 credit, 4 lecture, 6 lab)

Teaches and trains the nursing assistant to assist in patient care and function as effective members of the nursing team, under the supervision of a Registered Professional Nurse, in hospitals, nursing homes, and home health care settings. Orient to the work environment and responsibilities needed for quality patient care and good employee morale. **Pre-Requisite:** All students must complete a criminal background check according to current Illinois Department of Public Health guidelines. A fee is required for this background check and will be the responsibility of the student. Students must have a score of 20 or higher on the Reading portion of the ACT or a score of 54 on the AccuPlacer test and/or 4 or 5 on the PARCC, (or complete READ 106-3 at SIC with a grade of “C” or better). Those who do not achieve this score will have the option of taking READ 106 during the same semester as the CNA program.
