

Reading

READ 101 Reading Improvement (4 credit, 4 lecture, 0 lab)

Designed to promote and improve flexible reading rate, critical thinking skills such as skimming, scanning, and notetaking, vocabulary skills, and reading comprehension skills. This course may be offered as variable credit and repeatable three times. **Pre-Requisite:** Mandatory placement into this 3-credit hour course if score is 34 or less on ASSET Reading Test. If score is 35-40, placement into course is recommended. No prerequisites if ASSET Test 41 or higher. This course may not be taken in lieu of READ 106, or READ 108. It is recommended that this course be taken in conjunction with other reading courses and other basic skills courses. This course may be repeated three times.

READ 106 Introductory Reading (3 credit, 3 lecture, 0 lab)

Designed for the student who needs to increase college-level vocabulary, improve comprehension, and learn reading skills necessary for completing research. Students practice with computers to improve their reading rates.

READ 108 College Reading (2 credit, 2 lecture, 0 lab)

Designed to sharpen students' reading skills in order to read college-level material with greater speed and comprehension. Emphasized improving reading skills needed to complete successful research. Students enrolled in classes with extensive reading requirements and research papers will find the class beneficial.
